Honors Program. The Honors Program is encouraged for Art History majors who are considering attending graduate school. To be eligible for the program, a student must have a grade point average of 3.7 in the major or consent of the major adviser. In addition to meeting the standard major requirements, the honors student completes one undergraduate proseminar (course 190 or 190A-H), and writes an honors thesis (course 194H).
